Dear Swiss Chamber of Commerce in Türkiye Members and Readers,

It is a great pleasure to write these lines to you as the new Economic and Culture Counselor at the Swiss Embassy in Ankara. My family and I moved to Ankara this summer and since then, we have the pleasure to discover the Turkish way of life. Despite the economically challenging circumstances, we found a very welcoming and warm environment and we settled in very well. As 2023 comes to an end, the first few months in my new role already brought impactful cooperation projects.

Cooperation is crucial, in good times but especially in difficult times. In October, we supported French Swiss artist Saypé for an earthquake relief art project in Hatay. He showed us how zero waste art can capture a moment in our common memory and bring hope to people in need. With the support for this project, we remembered the victims of the tragic earthquakes earlier in 2023 and we reaffirmed our solidarity with Türkiye and the people in the earthquake affected areas.

For the celebration of the centenary of the Republic and the Treaty of Lausanne, the Swiss Embassy and the Consulate General could count on the much-appreciated support of many sponsors to make our vision of the commemoration of this special occasion come true. As a lasting memory, we planted a specific variety of a Swiss "Damassine" plum tree at the Residence of the Swiss Embassy in Ankara and on the campus of the University of Ankara. The trees were especially cultivated from Pleujouse in the Swiss Jura and are said to have their origins in this region. As these trees grow, may our Swiss-Turkish friendship and collaboration grow. Together with the Consulate General, we brought an original composition by Swiss artist, François Lindemann to Türkiye for two friendship concerts. They were performed by Turkish and Swiss soloists, among them musicians from the Presidential Symphony Orchestra (CSO) and well-known Turkish percussionist Okay Temiz. The premiere took place in the prestigious hall of the CSO in Ankara in November, followed by a concert at the equally renowned CRR hall in Istanbul.

Finally, as we are all acutely aware, climate change is one of the major challenges of our time. Switzerland has committed itself to net-zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050 and Türkiye by 2053. To achieve this goal, we must use all existing and newly emerging technologies to make the way we use energy on this planet more sustainable. In November, Dr. David Reber from the Swiss Federal Laboratories for Materials Science and Technology (Empa) joined us as a speaker for two events: A joint event on new energy technologies organized together with the Turkish Ministry of Trade and our colleagues from the German Turkish Chamber of Commerce and from Advantage Austria at the Energy is Future Congress and for the Swiss Turkish Economic Forum organized by the Swiss Chamber of Commerce in Türkiye. He shared insights into the challenges of storage technologies and on his research on flow batteries. Both events showed untapped potential for Swiss Turkish collaborations and we will continue to facilitate such exchanges between Swiss and Turkish researchers and companies for 2024 and beyond

With these thoughts, I convey to you my warmest regards, and best wishes for 2024

Mr Temizkan, tell us a little bit about your background.

After graduating from Baden-Wuerttemberg Cooperative State University Villingen-Schwenningen, Department Banking, I have worked for Deutsche Bank AG, Stuttgart, as Customer Relationship Manager for 8 years. I joined Liebherr Group in 20008 and started to work as Head of Finance of Liebherr Türkiye and Liebherr Azerbaijan. In 2010 I was appointed as Managing Director Finance & Administration in Türkiye and I have also served as Managing Director in Liebherr Azerbaijan from 2010 until 2018.

What is your impression of Türkiye and the Turkish market so far?

Türkiye is a dynamic market for us. Especially the need for infrastructure projects, like highway, railway constructions, energy and logistic investments in the country have been important for our growth. We also expect that investments in green-energy, e.g. Wind energy projects, logistic facilities, e.g. ports, and other infrastructure will remain dynamic, due to the geographic location and growing population of the country, so that our growth potential is still ongoing.

Name us three extraordinary things about Liebherr Türkiye?

The Liebherr Group is a family-run technology company with a broadly diversified product portfolio, which includes a total of 13 product segments. The creative exchange between the segments promotes the development of innovations and visionary technologies, fascinating products and services, which make a real difference. Liebherr aims to inspire their customers with all their solutions. In doing so, the limits of what was previously feasible are being redefined time and time again, meaning Liebherr often also contributes to the technological progress.

What is the biggest challenge Liebherr Türkiye is facing in Türkiye?

There are several challanges, we face in Türkiye, like high inflation, volatile exchange rate situation and fast changing regulatory conditions. But from our point of view one major challange is shortage of skilled blue-collar labour. There is a huge need for technicians with mechanical, electrical and hydraulic know-how and language skills.

What are the gains?

Despite the challenges we face, a dynamic environment with business opportunities in Türkiye allowed us to grow steadily. Our diversified and tailor-made product portfolio with innovations is matching with customer needs, so that we were able to serve as preferred partner for landmark projects. Some examples for this projects are Istanbul New Aiport, Çanakkale Bridge, Akkuyu Nuclear Power Plant, Yusufeli Hydropower plant, Ankara-Niğde Highway Construction and several high-speed train construction projects.

What future plans does Liebherr Türkiye hold and what are the upcoming projects? We see high potential in the green transformation, as our innovative products play a key role in this manner. Our efforts in alternative transmission solutions on the one hand and energy-efficient production methods on the other hand will help us to contribute to a greener future.

Another main topic is digital transformation for us. With the aid of new information technologies and digital data, new solutions and business models will be developed to help customers deal with the challenges they currently face. Liebherr is working systematically to stay one step ahead in this digital transformation. We see digitalisation as an opportunity to enhance existing services and to develop completely new business models.

Digitalisation will allow us to make existing services even more efficient, such as condition monitoring or jobsite planning for our customers. Products like Remote Service App, Crane Planner 2.0 or MyLiebherr.com are already used digital solutions, in order to assist our customers arround their Liebherr products. All these services will be more and more used here in Turkey, too. Is there anything else you would like to add that would be of interest to our SCCT newsletter readers? 
November 17th 2023, Swissôtel The Bosphorus, Istanbul «XVII.SWISS-TURKISH ECONOMIC FORUM»




